



Sandy River Basin Turtle Survey Points

Points	Latitude	Longitude	Site description
1	45.55345	-122.37426	Channel Pond, OP from west end which will be less obscured by vegetation as spring progresses.
2	45.55476	-122.38006	West end of channel at mainstem Sandy River. Weak view of west bank, good view of new cottonwood jam.
3	45.55386	-122.37701	old dyke site, sandy bar with backwater pond. near OP2, OP from east end with boulder row. Likely overrun with dog activity.
4	45.55386	-122.37701	old dyke site, same as OP3 but from west end on sandy bar; good view of backwater pond, look into willowy backwater on west end of backwater pond, good view of cottonwood jam visible from OP2.
5	45.55398	-122.3775	On same bar, view of finger and wood jam to the east in main channel.
Walking Survey 6			Walking survey between point 6a and 6c. Take 30-45 minutes moving slowly. Not much basking material but lots of sandy and rocky shore on Sundial Island side. Potential nesting area near point 6c.
6A	45.5555	-122.37316	Start of walking survey 6
6B	45.55559	-122.37061	Stop for about 10-15mins
6C	45.55585	-122.36927	End of walking survey 6
7	45.55595	-122.36564	30 minute OP. Around bend from OP 6c. View of more open potential nesting area and cottonwood logs downstream.
Walking Survey 8			Walking survey between 8a and 8c. Take 30-45 minutes moving slowly. Some basking material with cottonwood snags.
8A	45.55595	-122.36564	Start of walking survey 8
8B	45.55753	-122.36443	Stop for about 10-15mins
8C	45.55811	-122.36258	End of walking survey 8
9	45.55811	-122.36258	Elevated with view of delta islands at mouth of channel, can see into Columbia. Lots of debris and islands.
10	45.55899	-122.36056	below slatted bird blind. View of delta and Columbia. Somewhat mobile using surveyor discretion as there is lots of vegetation.
